Lösung

- 1** Tim went into the garden because he thought his parents might be there.
- 2** Lisa went into the hall because she wanted to hear the voices from upstairs better.
- 3** Lisa thinks Tim's parents can't be happy because they are arguing about how they don't spend enough time together.
- 4** Tim's mother doesn't want to meet Lisa because she comes from the worst part of town.

e)

Lösung

- 1** I think Lisa feels uncomfortable about meeting Tim's parents because they have a lot more money than her family does. The text says, 'Tim's parents had a lot of money, not like Lisa's parents.' (ll. 11–12)
- 2** Tim tries to make Lisa feel more relaxed by saying, 'Don't be so nervous. They're only my parents'. (ll. 28–29) He also shows her that he's by her side. The text says, 'He squeezed her hand'. (l. 30)
- 3** Although they have a lot of money, they aren't happy: Tim's father is at the office all the time and Tim's mother wants to have more time together with him in the family. Tim's mother says, 'We have a beautiful house, but you spend all your time at the office. What kind of life is this?' (ll. 75–77)
